CSA Add-Ons

Fresh Flower Bouquet – if you select this add-on, you will receive a fresh cut flower bouquet from our farm **10 weeks** in the summer.

Jarred/Canned good – if you select this add-on, you will receive a locally produced jarred/canned good each week. Examples include: honey, apple butter, jellies/jams, salsa, barbeque sauce, etc.

Double Fruit – if you select this add-on, you will receive double the fruit in your box each week.

Ice Cream – grab a cone, milkshake, or sundae when you pick up your CSA on Thursday. You will receive 20 coupons on your first pick up date. These are good for any ice cream treat (excludes pints and quarts). Must be used by the end of the 2024 ice cream season.

*Fresh Flower Bouquet runs for 10 weeks. It begins in July and runs into September.

New for 2024! Pick Your Own CSA!

This CSA option is geared towards our customers who appreciate and want to support local farmers, but a traditional CSA may not fit your needs for several reasons: numerous vacation weeks during the season, not adventurous with meal preparation, or a work schedule that is not conducive to a set pick up day. You may be someone who loves strawberries and wants to get just strawberries during that season – this option will allow you to do that.

You, as the consumer remain committed to purchasing local produce and provide the farmer with income during some of the highest output months (winter and spring). You will receive a debit card at the beginning of the season; you will pick it up the first time your visit the farm market on or after May 30, 2024. You will have until December 24, 2024, to use the debit card on local fruits and vegetables. All eligible produce will be marked in the farm market as it will change as the growing season changes. The debit card will be loaded with the dollar value of the CSA you choose, plus 10%.

CSA Agreement/Application

I have read and understand the above conditions and agree to pick up my produce on the CSA pick up day. I understand that shares cannot be personalized and if I fail to pick up my produce at the designated time without notifying D&S Produce, then my share may not be available to me. It is my responsibility to remember and D&S Produce will not contact me if I forget to pick up my share. If I have chosen the Pick Your Own CSA option, I understand the first day I can use my CSA card is May 30, 2024 and the balance must be used by December 24, 2024. Any remaining balance on the card will be property of D&S Produce. I understand that I can only purchase locally grown produce with this membership card.

If I am running late or cannot pick up my share on the designated day, **I will contact D&S Produce @ 717-357-3552 before the closing time for pick up so arrangements can be made to pick up my share later that evening or the next day.** I understand that my share will consist of an assortment of produce depending on availability and maturation. By signing this agreement, I fully understand the seasonality of Pennsylvania agriculture and remain open-minded to our changing availability. As a member, I share the risk along with all the other CSA members, in knowing that Mother Nature is in control and that D&S Produce will do it's very best in providing me with the appropriate amount of produce that is available weekly. I understand that my payment is nonrefundable.
